

Caring for Your New Scooter

The following is a list of “best practices” we have compiled over the years for using and maintaining your scooter. - 1. Use only Premium Gasoline in your scooter, the scooter WILL NOT function properly with any fuel below 90 Octane. If possible, find a filling station that has a designated/separate Premium Fuel nozzle or keep a 2-3 gallon gas can be filled with Premium Gasoline at your place of residence to maintain your fuel level.**
- 2. It is highly recommended to add Fuel Stabilizer directly to your gas tank whenever you fill up. FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS specified on the bottle for proper mixing amount (usually 1 oz. or less per gallon). If you keep a 2-3 gallon gas can at your place of residence, you can pre-treat the fuel with Fuel Stabilizer per the directions specified on the bottle.**
- 3. Change your engine and gear oil after the first 300-500 miles with the recommended oil per your Owner’s Manual. DO NOT OVERFILL OIL. Campus Scooter does provide this service.**
- 4. After initial oil change, change engine and gear oil every 1,000 to 1,500 miles or as recommended in Owner’s Manual. DO NOT OVERFILL OIL.**
- 5. Let your scooter idle for 2-3 minutes before driving whenever possible.**
- 6. Avoid driving for prolonged periods at top-speed during first 300-mile break in period. It is strongly recommended that you do not exceed 30 MPH during this break in period.**
- 7. You should ALWAYS protect your scooter from the elements. Buy a scooter cover if you leave your scooter outside. This will help to alleviate water and snow damage and minimize water getting into your gas tank. Campus Scooter does sell Scooter Covers.**
- 8. Use the kick-start rather than the electric start whenever possible. It is particularly important that you kick-start the scooter for the first start each day. This will double or triple the life of your battery.**
